## Call for Abstracts

Abstracts and posters representative of recent research are invited. All abstracts are to be submitted electronically to [mu-cvday@missouri.edu](mailto:mu-cvday@missouri.edu) no later than January 18, 2016 to be included in the abstract competition. Abstract Format: Title of Presentation; Authors (presenting author first, in bold); Institutional Affiliation; Body of abstract is not to exceed 300 words in a Word file using Times New Roman "12" font.

## Student and Postdoctoral Abstract/Poster Competition

Undergraduates, graduate students and postdoctoral fellows are invited to participate in the abstract competition. Abstracts will be initially judged on the merit of the study and ability to communicate. Abstracts should contain a brief introduction, rationale, statement of methods, results and a discussion/conclusion. The abstract is expected to be prepared by the candidate, in consultation with the faculty mentor. Final judging will be based on the poster presentation. Awards will be given to the top 2 Post Doctoral Fellow and top 2 Student Posters.

The highlight of Cardiovascular Day is the **James O. Davis Distinguished Lecture in Cardiovascular Science**. Dr. Davis is considered the pioneer in cardiovascular science at MU and is internationally recognized for his research contributions in the areas of congestive heart failure and hypertension.
